General Policy Statement

The Company recognises that it has a responsibility to ensure that all reasonable precautions are taken to provide and maintain working conditions which are safe and healthy and comply with all statutory requirements and codes of practice.

As part of our commitment to protecting the health, safety and welfare of our employees, we recognise that workplace stress is a health and safety issue and acknowledge the importance of identifying and reducing workplace stressors.

The executive responsible for safety is accountable for ensuring that appropriate health and safety practices are adopted throughout the company. All employees must help create and maintain a safe working environment by:

- Co-operating with management by following safe systems of work;
- Reporting all accidents and potential safety hazards to management and co-operate with the investigation of accidents;
- Taking care of their health and safety and not endangering others who may be affected by their acts or omissions;
- Not interfering with, or abusing, any items of safety equipment
- Ensuring that working areas are maintained in a clean and tidy condition and that passageways and fire exits are kept clear
